Plano Model Products - #14862 GP18 / GP20 Intake Grilles - Proto2000 models

These stainless steel intake grilles are designed to be used on the Proto2000 GP18 and GP20 models. They can be added to a predecorated or undecorated model.

If you are adding these to a built model and the plastic grilles are firmly attached to the model, Carefully trim away the plastic wire grilles from the frame holding them, leaving the old frame in place. You will need a smooth flat surface to hold the new grilles.

If you are working on a unbuilt undecorated model you have a couple of options in preparing your model for the new grilles. You can use the Delrin grilles that come with the model and modify them as described above. OR you can use .030 X .015 styrene strips to build new frames in the shell cavities.

Remove stainless grilles from fret and clean up edges if needed. Using an adhesive that will stick to Delrin (Microscale MicroBond or Barge glue) attach stainless grilles to appropriate intake opening with the drain holes on the bottom. Once grilles are attached, you will need to add the upper rain rail (for lack of actual name). The rails are keyed to fit down over the grilles and also into the cavity to help hold them vertically. Once rail is seated down evenly across the top edge of the grille, run a very thin bead of (Microbond) glue between the grille and rail to hold it in place and seal off any visible seams.

Repeat on all grilles and touch up paint if needed.
